## JUROR'S STATEMENT

It was a great pleasure being this year's juror for the Connecticut Academy of Fine Arts virtual themed juried show "Uncertainty" hosted on the CAFA website. I am impressed by the response to the call for entry and the caliber of the work that was submitted.

This year there were 169 submissions, submitted by 96 artists. Through the jurying process, 98 works were selected for the online exhibition, representing a range of art methods and genres.

When making the selections I took into consideration the strength of the work, the overall fit of the artwork between form vs. content and expression.

It was certainly a challenge to narrow down the selections, but it was also exciting to see the diversity and quality of the online work coming together. Curious works included in the exhibition delved into the idea of 'uncertainty', reflecting the idea of hesitation and reluctance while in the process of art making, enabling oneself to search intensely and make such fine discoveries.

Congratulations to all the artists in the exhibition.

## AWARDS



BEST OF SHOW Sarah Warda *The Hay Maze* Oil on Linen First prize is awarded to "The Hay Maze" oil on linen chosen for its narrative motif of a figure wandering in a physical maze reflecting the uncertainty and for the high level of skill with oil paints.



SECOND PLACE Janvier Miller *Selfie* Acrylic on Canvas Second prize is awarded to "Selfie" acrylic on canvas, chosen for the motif of the artist at work while the viewer/audience watch the artist in action of contemplation and discovery making. The artist expressed herself with very fine use of paint.



THIRD PLACE William Butcher *The Parable of the Seed Sower* Acrylic/Foam Board on Canvas Third prize is awarded to "The Parable of the Seed Sower" acrylic on board and canvas, chosen for its abstract/figurative expression of uncertainty and more ambiguous narrative.



HONORABLE MENTION Matthew Derezinski *Foresight* Digital/Photography The artist designed a darker monochromatic setting with a single clear and colorful image – the butterfly. The contrast between the title of the image, Foresight, to the title of the show, Uncertainty, creates a tension between the two images. A moment of clarity in this unknown path.
